

RESOLUTION NO. 16-25, 2016

COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO

ESTABLISHING JUST AND EQUITABLE SERVICE CHARGES DURING THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 2016 THROUGH MARCH 2017 IN CONNECTION WITH THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM UNDEDICATED TOWNSHIP ROADS

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.82 authorizes a Board of Township Trustees to remove snow and ice from an undedicated road, in the event the owner of the undedicated road fails to provide for the removal of snow and ice, following notice, during the six month period following the adoption of a resolution declaring that an imminent emergency exists which threatens life or property; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.82, and limited home-rule powers under R.C. 504.04, authorize a Board of Township Trustees to adopt and enforce within the unincorporated area of the township local police, sanitary, and other similar regulations that are not in conflict with general laws; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 505.82 the Board desires to establish just and equitable service charges for the removal of snow and ice from all such undedicated roads and directing notice to the owner and certification of the charges to the County Auditor in accordance with R.C. 505.82.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, pursuant to Sections 505.82 and 504.04 of the Revised Code, as follows:

SECTION 1:

The Board hereby establishes just and equitable service charges for the removal of snow and ice from undedicated township roads for the period from October 2016 through March 2017 to be incorporated in the amount each property owner on an undedicated street pays for the Columbia Township Road District levy.
