Section 1. That the Auditor and the Treasurer of Hamilton County in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 321.34, be requested to draw and pay to Columbia township, Hamilton County upon the written request of Caroline Heekin, Fiscal Officer or C. Michael Lemon, Township Administrator to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement of 2017 derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, and lawfully applicable for purposes of fiscal year 2017.

Section 2. That the Fiscal Officer or Township Administrator of Columbia Township, Hamilton County shall forward to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.
