The Little Miami Joint Fire District will place a 2-mill levy on the ballot in May. We expect opposition due to "Levy fatigue". The sense of urgency appears to be focused on financing as we start to get a real sense of the actual costs of services.

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The possible 20 Acre Whetsel Development continues to gain momentum. Geotech borings will be important. We hope to establish a PUD to protect township interests.

The Vacation of Locust Street is being pursued due to heavy costs of repair. The only homeowners on the street are happy with the decision.

Bob Wendell has retired as fire inspector and will be recognized in March with a proclamation.
