

RESOLUTION 20-42, 2021
COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO

**ESTABLISHING JUST AND EQUITABLE SERVICE CHARGES FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE
FROM UNDEDICATED TOWNSHIP ROADS THROUGH APRIL 30, 2022, DISPENSING WITH THE
SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.82 authorizes a Board of Township Trustees to remove snow and ice from an undedicated road, in the event the undedicated road owner has not provided for the removal of snow and ice, following oral notice, during the six-month period following the adoption of a resolution declaring that an imminent emergency exists which threatens life or property within the township; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.82, and limited home-rule powers under R.C. 504.04, authorize a Board of Township Trustees to adopt and enforce within the unincorporated area of the township local police, sanitary, and other similar regulations that are not in conflict with general laws; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 505.82 the Board desires to establish just and equitable service charges for the removal of snow and ice from all such undedicated roads and directing notice to the owner and certification of the charges to the County Auditor in accordance with R.C. 505.82.

WHEREAS, this resolution shall be adopted as an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety or welfare of the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Board, upon majority vote, hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading; and,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, pursuant to Sections 505.82 and 504.04 of the Revised Code, as follows:

SECTION 1:

The Board hereby establishes just and equitable service charges for the removal of snow and ice from undedicated township roads through April 30, 2022 as determined by the Administrator and Road Superintendent, based on a formula calculating the actual time spent and resources used to remove snow and ice.

SECTION 2:





Under R.C. 5705.19 this resolution goes into immediate effect upon passage, and the emergency powers under this Resolution shall be in effect through April 30, 2022.
