

**RESOLUTION 21-50, 2020**  
**COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO**

**AUTHORIZING TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AND APPROVING  
CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES WITH HAMILTON  
COUNTY SHERIFF AND HAMILTON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS FOR JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023,  
DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, police protection services are necessary for the public welfare of, and benefit all, residents of and businesses within Columbia Township, Hamilton County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has determined it will make available funds to provide these police protection services through current and future levies and general funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township, the Board of Hamilton County Commissioners, and the Hamilton County Sheriff, pursuant to Sections 311.29, 503.43, 504.16, and 505.50 of the Ohio Revised Code, may enter into this agreement for police protection services on a regular basis; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 1, 2021, the Parties entered into a three-year Agreement for Police Protection Services for January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023, entitled "Agreement for Police Protection Services ("Original Agreement") for the provision and payment of police protection services. The Original Agreement provides for periodic reviews of actual expenses and appropriate adjustments during the course of the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties have determined it is in their best interests to amend the Original Agreement to provide two twenty-four hour shifts three hundred sixty-five days per year to patrol Columbia Township;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, upon majority vote, hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees, for the benefit and welfare of Columbia Township and its citizens, hereby agrees to amend the Original Agreement with the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners and the Hamilton County Sheriff for police protection services for January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023, as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 2022, regardless of execution date, the Parties agree that Columbia Township shall pay for, and the Sheriff shall provide, two twenty-four hour shifts three hundred sixty-five days per year as set forth in Exhibit A.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Be it further resolved that this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,

health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to increase the level of police protection services necessary to assure continued public safety and welfare as the Township's population and businesses increase in number and generate greater demand for patrol services.

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES**

This Amendment to the Agreement for Police Protection Services is made by and between the Sheriff of Hamilton County, Ohio ("Sheriff"), the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio ("Board"), and the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio ("Village"), collectively the "Parties."

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2021, the Parties entered into an Agreement for Police Protection Services ("Original Agreement") for the provision and payment of police protection services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined it is in their best interests to amend the Original Agreement to provide two twenty-four hour shifts three hundred sixty-five days per year to patrol Columbia Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, agree to amend the Original Agreement as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 2022, regardless of execution date, the Parties agree that Columbia Township shall pay for, and the Sheriff shall provide, two twenty-four hour shifts three hundred sixty-five days per year as set forth in Exhibit A.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


