

**RESOLUTION 21- 51, 2021**  
**COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO**

**AUTHORIZING COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE 2018 AGREEMENT WITH THE DEER PARK-SILVERTON JOINT FIRE DISTRICT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND AMBULANCE SERVICES IN THE SILVERTON FIRE DISTRICT, COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio has deemed it to be in the best interests of the Township to enter into a Fire Protection and Ambulance Services Agreement ("Agreement") for the Silverton Fire District, Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio for the period April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2021 with the Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District ("District"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has been well-served by the Agreement for the past three years, and, the Board of Trustees at its March 9, 2021 meeting amended the Agreement to continue services from April 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio desires to continue the District's services provided via the Agreement under the same terms through February 28, 2022 at the rate set forth below; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to enter into a new, separate agreement with the District, effective March 1, 2022, for combined services covering the Silverton Fire District and Ridge Fire District.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, upon majority vote, hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, for the benefit and welfare of Columbia Township and its citizens hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to enter into an amendment to the Agreement with the Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District for fire protection and ambulance services per the following schedule:

01/01/2022 – 02/28/2022 monthly fee of \$6,043.50

Be it further resolved that this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to authorize a contract amendment so that the Silverton Fire District will continue to receive fire protection and ambulance services necessary for the public welfare.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BETWEEN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, OHIO  
AND THE DEER PARK-SILVERTON JOINT FIRE DISTRICT**

This SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BETWEEN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, OHIO AND THE DEER PARK-SILVERTON JOINT FIRE DISTRICT (the "Amendment") is made as of the 9<sup>th</sup> day of NOVEMBER, 2021 by and between Columbia Township, Ohio, an Ohio limited home rule township ("Columbia"), and Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District, an Ohio joint fire district ("District"), under the following circumstances:

A. Pursuant to an Agreement for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services Between Columbia Township, Ohio and the Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District executed in April 2018 (the "Original Agreement"), the District agreed to provide fire protection and emergency medical services to the Silverton Fire District through March 31, 2021.

B. Pursuant to a First Amendment to the Original Agreement executed in February, 2021, the District agreed to provide fire protection and emergency medical services to the Silverton Fire District through December 31, 2021.

C. Columbia and the District hereby wish to continue the services provided under the Original Agreement and to amend it on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. The terms of the Original Agreement are hereby extended from January 1, 2022 through February 28, 2022.
2. For the months of January 2022 through February 2022, Columbia shall pay the District a monthly fee of \$6,043.50.
3. Unless otherwise amended or altered as provided in this Second Amendment, the Original Agreement is hereby ratified and confirmed.
