

**RESOLUTION 22 - 35, 2022**  
**COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO**

**DESIGNATING A NO PARKING AREA ON ASHLEY OAKS DRIVE BETWEEN US-50  
AND EXTENDING 30 FEET NORTH OF THE ENTRANCE SPEED LIMIT SIGN AND  
PROHIBITING PARKING THEREIN, AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, Columbia Township is authorized by Ohio Revised Code §505.17 to make such regulations as are necessary to control vehicle parking in the unincorporated area of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined a need exists for establishing No Parking at the entrance of Ashley Oaks Drive to improve safety for motorists entering and exiting US-50. US-50 is a five-lane federal highway with an Average Daily Traffic count of 22,000 – 26,000 vehicles, and there is no traffic signal at the intersection with Ashley Oaks Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, TEC, Columbia Township's transportation safety engineering consultant, advises that the Township is authorized under the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (OMUTCD) to install No Parking signs on both sides of Ashley Oaks Drive from US-50 and extending up to approx. 30 feet beyond the first speed limit sign for a total distance of 220 feet. OMUTCD code permits No Parking when there is limited sight distance (in this location due to multiple curves, a hill, and physical obstructions) and high speeds (required to enter/exit US-50).

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, upon majority vote, hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, for the benefit and welfare of Columbia Township and its citizens, declares both sides of Ashley Oaks Drive between US-50 and extending up to approx. 30 feet beyond the first speed limit sign, a total distance of 220 feet, to be a No Parking area and prohibits parking therein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Board authorizes the Township Administrator or her designee to publicize this parking regulation per applicable requirements and to display the appropriate signage notifying the public of this ban and also authorizes the Hamilton County Sheriff to enforce this regulation as provided under the Ohio Revised Code.
