

**RESOLUTION 22 – 61, 2022
COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO**

REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO MAKE ADVANCE PAYMENT OF TAXES

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code allows a taxing authority to request payment from the County Auditor funds derived from taxes or other sources to the County Treasurer, which may be held on account of a local subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, for the benefit and welfare of Columbia Township and its citizens:

Section 1. That the Auditor and the Treasurer of Hamilton County, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 321.34, be requested to draw and pay to Columbia Township, Hamilton County, upon the written request of Fiscal Officer Caroline Heekin or Township Administrator Melissa Taylor to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement of 2022 derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, and lawfully applicable for purposes of fiscal year 2022.




Section 2. That the Fiscal Officer or Township Administrator of Columbia Township, Hamilton County shall forward to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.
