Trustees in attendance were David Kubicki and Steve Brokamp. Also in attendance was Township Administrator Melissa Taylor serving as the Fiscal Officer. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

The Special Meeting was a Trustee Work Session for the Board and Administrator to discuss proposed public improvements in the eastern Walton Creek Road area neighborhood originally established as Plainville. The neighborhood is comprised of Pear, Elm, Spring, Orchard, and Beech streets.

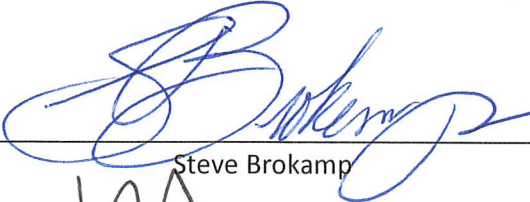
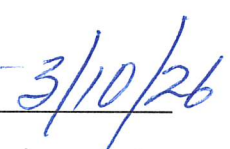
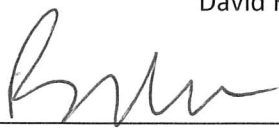
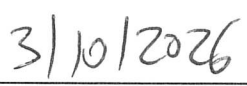
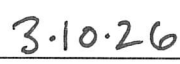
